Scope of Service

Environmental Design Group serves as the Construction Project Engineer (CPE) in accordance with ODOT LPA requirements, with construction administration tasks including daily reports, leading progress meetings, schedule review and tracking, reviewing contractor pay requests, tracking quantities, responding to RFI'S, change order documentation, quality control and specification adherence and utility coordination.

Project Description

This ODOT local let LPA project includes the widening and reconstruction of Cleveland-Massillon Road. Work items included installation of a new roundabout, replacement of Schocalog Run and Rosemont Golf Course culverts, reconstruction of the I-77 northbound exit ramp, and upgraded signalization and lighting. Additional items include curbs, sidewalk, stamped concrete, 10' shared-use path, drainage, new water lines, sanitary modifications, utility relocation, new signing and pavement markings. This section of the road is well traveled, and communicating road closures and detours to public service and residents is important. Large scale dewatering and creek re-routing was needed to set the large storm water structures and culverts to meet the deadline.
